In August 2015, on the occasion of the XIX refresher course of the SPR, the Bracco

Foundation Bracco announced a call for three scholarships dedicated to young Brazilian radiologists.

The selected candidates have the opportunity to attend a period of specialisation in Italy, lasting 45 days, in order to exam in depth the main methods used in diagnostic imaging. The aim is to contribute to cutting-edge scientific training for Brazilian radiologists of the future.

The winners - following a merit-based selection process carried out by a scientific committee - were all assigned a mentor as a scientific guide, who offered them technical advice during their stay.
