CEO of CERC - European Cardiovascular Research Center Marie-Claude Morice graduated in Medicine in 1973 at the Paris University of Medicine and in 1975 obtained a specialisation in Cardiology. She worked in the Centre Cardiologique du Nord from 1976 to 1995: first as head of the Department of Haemodynamics until 1984 and later as head of the Department of Invasive Cardiology.

Until 1995 she was Director of the Southern Paris Cardiovascular Institute at the Jaques Cartier Hospital. In 1995 she was nominated Best Clinical Researcher" by the Erasmus University of Rotterdam and in 1997 was voted "Cardiologist of the Year" by Abstract Cardio.

Since 2000 she has been co-director of EuroPCR. She is Honorary Prof of the Universidad del Salvador in Buenos Aires and is co-founder of the Indo – French Foundation of Interventional Cardiology. She is regularly invited to participate as a guest of the Faculty and President in all the leading cardiology conferences in Europe, Asia and the USA (TEAM congress, Madrid; JIM, Rome, TCT,AHA, ACC).

She is director-general of CERC (European Cardiovascular Research Center), founded in 2008.
